MIRUS' *A PATH OF HIS OWN* TO SCREEN AT BRITISH MUSEUM

BRAMPTON, ONTARIO, June 1, 2005 -- The British Museum in London, England has announced that the Mirus Films/Film Arts production *A Path of His Own: The Story of David B. Milne* will be screened twice as part of the touring exhibition "David Milne Watercolours: Painting Toward the Light." The free, lunchtime screenings will be on July 22 and August 4, 2005.

"Painting Toward the Light", which features 80 Milne works, was curated by the Art Gallery of Ontario's Katharine Lochnan and is a rare example of a Canadian show touring internationally. The show will be on display at the British Museum from July 7 to September 25. After the London showing, the exhibition will play in New York City at the Metropolitan Museum of Art from November 8 to January 29, 2006. Following this, it will come home to the Art Gallery of Ontario (AGO) from February 25 to May 21, 2006. *A Path of His Own* will be screened as part of the AGO exhibition, with dates and times to be determined later.

A Path of His Own features Les Carlson as David Milne and is based on Milne's journals, letters, and his unpublished autobiography. It was written by Pat Patterson and produced and directed by Paul Caulfield. The sixty-minute documentary-drama won seven Canadian Film & Television Association Awards including Best Direction and Best Overall Production. The film has aired on CBC-TV, Radio-Canada, TVOntario, Bravo, and Vision TV.
